THE STANDARDS OF THE CONSERVATOIRE CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

All members of the Conservatoire community are expected to adhere to this Conservatoire Code of Behaviour and are therefore asked to:

Create and maintain the relationship of trust and confidence between you, your School community and the wider Conservatoire

Be a polite, courteous, and responsible citizen, look out for other members of the Conservatoire community and beyond – be an active bystander. Comply with instructions as required (including government instructions in the event of a pandemic or other crisis)

Show consideration and respect at all times towards others, irrespective of role, position or background

Create and maintain an inclusive and supportive learning environment and pastoral environment for all

Show empathy with others. Accept that others may not necessarily share your point of view, and be respectful of differences of opinion. Recognise that people do not all start from the same starting points, and that individuals may face very different challenges and obstacles

Take the time to get to know your peers, both in your School and across the Conservatoire, be supportive of them and those who work with you at all levels and seek to understand their point of view

Be aware of the need for reflection and independent study in taking responsibility for your own learning and development, and in order to see genuine progress

Adhere to local School Student and Staff Codes of Conduct

Understand and be familiar with the Conservatoire's definitions of unacceptable behaviours as defined in the Conservatoire Policy on Sexual Misconduct, Harassment and Related Behaviours and Conservatoire Non-Academic Misconduct Policy.
