A Mixed Bill of Exceptional Repertoire

Monotones I by Frederick Ashton

The pinnacle of Ashton's classicism; Earthy with dramatic and weighty lunges, and gestures of shielding from the sun.

Run time: 10 minutes Cast size: 3 dancers

The Two Pigeons Pas de Deux by Frederick Ashton

A romantic Pas de Deux telling the story of a young couple, danced by Central's founder Christopher Gable in its first performance in 1961.

Run Time: 6 minutes Cast size: 2 dancers

Mirror Mirror (Excerpt) by Michael Pink

Choreographed by Ballet Central Co-Founder, now Artistic Director of Milwaukee Ballet, to music by Composer in Residence Phillip Feeney.

Run time: 10 minutes Cast size: 14 dancers

Dextera (Excerpt) by Sophie Laplane

Choreographer in Residence at Scottish Ballet and MA alumnus from Central. The piece showcases the pas de deux skills of the dancers.

Run time: 10 minutes Cast size: 16 dancers

Ballet Central 2023 Commissions

New creation by Morgann Runacre-Temple

Morgann graduated from Central School of Ballet in 2004 and is now Choreographer in Residence at Ballet Ireland. The vocabulary will be ballet-based but not on pointe and will be accompanied by a new commission from Composer in Residence, Phillip Feeney.

Run time: 15 minutes approx. Cast size: 15 dancers approx.

New creation by Darshan Singh-Bhuller

After a successful career as a dancer, choreographer, filmmaker, and director, Darshan has returned to freelance directing, choreographing and guest-teaching across the US and UK. He returns after 10 years to create an original piece on Ballet Central, after his work Mapping #3 was featured in the 2013 tour.
