

Undergraduate Personal Statement Guidance September 2024 Entry

All applicants – -ou are required to submit a personal statement as part of the application form. Your personal statement should reflect who you are as a person and should include the following:

- Why you want to train at Central School of Ballet
- Any training or performance highlights (e.g school/college shows)
- Performances you have seen
- Any awards or scholarships

You can submit this in a way that feels most accessible to you:

- Written [500 words max.]
- YouTube video [3 mins max.]
- Audition file [3 mins max.]

Year 2 and Year 3 Direct Entry Applicants Only – <u>in addition to the above</u>, you will need to provide a second statement, including further information about your experience in the following areas:

- Choreography
- Dance Improvisation
- Dance History
- Anatomy
- Nutrition
- Pilates
- Goal Setting
- Supplementary Training (i.e Exercise Programmes)

You can submit this in a way that feels most accessible to you:

- Written [500 words max.]
- YouTube video [3 mins max.]
- Audition file [3 mins max.]
